Residential Students

- **Price:** \$1,498

- **Application Fee:** Starting at \$99 (mandatory, non-refundable)

Student Life

Experience student life with your peers on the stunning campus of UC San Diego, overlooking the city's breathtaking landscapes. Known for having one of the most idyllic climates in the US, San Diego also boasts an array of beautiful locations to explore.



Lodging and Meals

At UCSD, our students are housed in suites. They'll share a room with another person, in a suite that contains 3-5 other rooms. Each suite has 2-4 bathrooms, depending on the number of rooms in the suite, as well as a common living room area. Suites are separated by gender. Most meals will be in the on-campus dining hall. The dining hall offers a wide selection of food, accommodating a variety of diets - including vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free, kosher, halal, and specific food allergies.



Afternoon Labs

In the afternoons, the middle school students participate in academic labs that will give them time to tinker on their course projects or work on a hands-on project that will bring their learning to life.



Requirements

- Middle School Program: Students must be between the ages of 11-13 and have finished 6th grade
- A grade point average of 3.0 (or equivalent)
