### ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The ability to speak English is fundamental for real-life success wherever you are from. More than grammar, reading and writing, this program will integrate English language learning with topics in cross-cultural understanding and key global issues while giving you the confidence needed to communicate in English in any situation. English Language learners will live amongst students from the U.S. In fact, 75% of our students are native English speakers, giving you plenty of opportunity to learn English both inside and outside the classroom. The program is held in exciting and vibrant cities providing international students a rare opportunity to experience a fun summer in the United States. Students have the opportunity to take one session in ESOL, and switch to an academic track for the second (and third!) session. A 5% discount applies for students

enrolling in multiple sessions, and Summer Springboard will provide inter-session programming as well at no additional charge.

## COURSE STRUCTURE

There are nine 3-hour class sessions over the two-week course. During week one, students have class from 9am-12pm, Monday - Friday.

During the week two students have class from 9am-12pm Monday through Thursday. Wednesday afternoons are dedicated to additional academic time (excursions, speakers).

## EXCURSIONS:

Students have the opportunity to pick and choose the excursions they would like to participate in, based on their own individual interests, giving them additional opportunities to interact with their American peers. Weekends are reserved for city tours and Six Flags excursions.

## TUITION RATES\*

### Residential Students: \$4,998

Includes: all meals, lodging, excursions, Academic Course, weekend excursions; Excludes: optional airport pickup/drop off service (available for an additional fee)

### Commuter Students: \$2,798

Includes: lunch, academic course, excursions, programming from 9am to 5pm, Monday-Friday; Excludes: lodging, breakfast, dinner, weekend excursions

### Extended Commuter Students: \$3,398

Includes: lunch, dinner, excursions, academic course, programming from 9am to 8pm, weekend excursions;

Excludes: lodging, breakfast

## TUITION SUPPLEMENTS:

- Application fee: \$99 (mandatory, non-refundable)
- Group airport transfers: \$95 each way. Transfers outside of the official group pick-up and drop-off time window are \$195 each way (optional)
- Unaccompanied minor transportation: \$50 additional fee each way (if using airport transfer)
