Campus Life

Boundaries

For students' own safety, Summer Springboard requires students to stay within a prescribed boundary

- Between the hours of 7:00am and 9:00pm, students are allowed outside of the Unit 1 complex, but they must stay within Dana Ave., University Dr., Piedmont Ave., and Haste St..
- Students should not hang out in *People's Park*. This is considered outside of program boundaries.
- Outside of these hours students must be inside unless attending official programming that requires them to be elsewhere.
- If students are found outside of the boundaries, these privileges can be revoked for the entire student body. Repeat offenders can be dismissed.
- While on excursions, boundaries will also be set, and students may not leave these boundaries.
- If a student should find themselves lost at any time, they should call their Resident Advisor or Campus Director immediately for assistance.

Groups of Three

Whether on an excursion or within the UC Berkeley boundaries, students should never travel alone. Students should always travel in groups of three.

If a student becomes separated from their group, they should immediately return to the Unit One complex, or, if on an excursion, to the Emergency Checkpoint.

Off Site Permission

- No student is permitted to leave the Summer Springboard program campus without prior written permission from a parent or guardian.
- To obtain offsite permission, speak with the Campus Director to obtain an offsite permission form.
- A phone call from a parent or guardian is not sufficient to grant offsite permission. Summer Springboard must have a signed permission form.
- The offsite form must be completed and received via fax, email or in-person at least 24 hours before the offsite activity.

Meals

- Residential students have three meals provided per day by Summer Springboard. However, they are free to eat out if they desire.
- Unless otherwise specified in the schedule, all meals will be eaten at Crossroads Dining Hall.
- Students may order food to be delivered to the dorm but it can only be received during free time and must arrive prior to RA check.
- Food delivery apps can all deliver to the dormitories

<u>Laundry</u>

- There are washers and dryers located on several floors of your dorm building. These machines are coin operated and cost approximately \$2 to wash and \$2 to dry.
- Remember to bring your own laundry detergent, powder or liquid.
