Residential Students

- Includes: all meals, lodging, excursions, academic course, weekend excursions

Commuter Students

Student Life

Students will live and study in St. Stephen's House, one of the former six Permanent Private Halls at the University of Oxford. Housed in a former monastery in a residential area, students will get the true feel of what it's like to live and learn in a traditional Academic Community, with the sites of Oxford at their fingertips.

Lodging and Meals

St. Stephen's House is set up like a quintessential English college. Each dorm room is unique in its own way; although there are doubles, most rooms are single. All rooms have a sink and some rooms have an en-suite bath, but the majority have access to hallway toilets and showers. Our residential staff will be living amongst students. Breakfast and lunch will be in the dining hall, with most dinners off-site. Dinner on the last night of the program will be a traditional Formal Meal! All dietaru restrictions can be accommodated.



College Readiness Workshops

All students participate in a rotation of workshops designed to engage youth with various skills for a successful transition to college. The workshop sessions cover Public Speaking, Financial Literacy, Leadership, and College Admissions. Led by experienced instructors, these workshops provide a solid foundation to help students navigate their future academic endeavors.
