### Residential Students

- **Includes:** all meals, lodging, excursions, academic course, weekend excursions
- **Excludes:** optional airport pickup and drop off service (available for an additional fee)
- **Price:** \$5,998

### Commuter Students

- **Includes:** lunch, academic course, excursions, programming from 9am to 5pm, Monday-Friday
- **Excludes:** lodging, breakfast, dinner, weekend excursions
  - Weekend excursions can be added on for \$125 per day
- **Price:** \$3,298

## Lodging and Meals

Summer Springboard students are housed in either double or triple rooms when dorming on the campus; although, triple rooms are more common. There is a shared bathroom within the room. Students are housed by gender, and genders are separated by room. Dorm rooms contain twin XL-sized beds, desks, drawers, mirror, and a closet. A basic linen package is included in the cost of the Residential tuition, and is provided by UCLA, in the form of a fitted sheet, flat sheet, blanket, pillow, pillowcase, and bath towel.

Breakfast and dinner will be in the on-campus dining hall, and students will be provided lunch money to buy lunch at any on-campus restaurant. The dining hall offers a wide selection of food, accommodating a variety of diets - including vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free, halal, and specific food allergies.



## College Readiness Workshops

All students participate in a rotation of workshops designed to engage youth with various skills for a successful transition to college. The workshop sessions cover Public Speaking, Financial Literacy, Leadership, and College Admissions. Led by experienced instructors, these workshops provide a solid foundation to help students navigate their future academic endeavors.
